Vietnam Veterans of America (VVA) is the only national Vietnam veterans organization congressionally chartered and exclusively dedicated to Vietnam-era veterans and their families. We have a national membership of over 85,000, with over 650 chapters throughout the United States, Puerto Rico, the Virgin Islands, Guam and the Philippines.

What We Do:

The VVA promotes the educational, economic, health, cultural, and emotional readjustment of the Vietnam-era veteran to civilian life. This is accomplished by promoting legislation and public-awareness programs to eliminate discrimination suffered by Vietnam veterans.
